



Community College Humanities Association American Academy in Rome Affiliated Fellowship

Eligibility:

This program is open to highly qualified scholars in the Humanities disciplines who hold a master's, doctorate or other terminal degree and have an affiliation with a community college.

Requirements (Packet of Materials):

1. Completed Application Cover Sheet (download from www.ccha-assoc.org)
2. Two Letters of Recommendation: from professionals acquainted with the applicant and his/her work – attached in sealed envelopes or sent separately.
3. Statement of Participation and Research Proposal: may be up to four pages and should be in the proposed field of study and outline the proposed research topic and plan.
4. A current Résumé/CV.
5. \$20 Application fee payable to Community College Humanities Association.

Guidelines:

CCHA is looking for a candidate who will go above and beyond to perform well and academically represent CCHA and community college faculty.

One candidate will be chosen.

Use Rome and the surrounding area as your platform for research.

Targeted areas of research:

1. Ancient Studies
2. Medieval Studies
3. Renaissance and Early Modern Studies
4. Modern Italian Studies

These disciplines are intended to be suggestive; therefore, any humanistic approach to these areas will be given consideration.

Conditions of Award:

One month residency at the **American Academy in Rome – June 6 – July 4, 2016**

You will be provided with room and board; lunch and dinner Monday through Friday; lunch on Saturday. You are expected to devote yourself full-time to your chosen project.

CCHA will provide up to \$1100 for travel expenses; anything over \$1100 must be covered by the chosen candidate.

In the year following the Fellowship, you are expected to conduct a workshop on your home campus and to present at least once at sessions of the CCHA regional or national conferences.
